Sub.: Eligibility criteria for Ph.D. programme for students graduating with a four years (or more) Bachelors program from any of the CFTIs with a CPI exceeding 8.0.

The Senate in its 239th Meeting held on 9th October 2019 **resolved to approve** the proposal of allowing students from CFTIs with CPI exceeding 8.0 on the scale of 10.0 to apply for Ph.D. programme of IIT Bombay without a GATE score.

The Senate noted that as per MHRD guidelines, only B.Tech. graduates of the IITs with CPI 8 or above (on scale of 10) are entitled to the TA/RAship without having to appear in GATE.

Therefore, the Senate decided that clear guidelines from MHRD be obtained regarding payment of MHRD TA/RAship for the students admitted from CFTIs with CPI 8 or above, without GATE score. The Senate also decided that eligibility criteria for application under TAP/RAP/PS categories to be suitably modified.
